PRELIMINARY CHAMPIONSHIP (BOYS & GIRLS)

Preliminary Championships in the Mid-Atlantic Region: Preliminary Championships are open to competitors who have places 1st in Prizewinner light (Reel or Slip Jig) and Treble (Jig or Hornpipe) dances. Girls and Boys combined. Preliminary dancers, who win THREE first places in a calendar year, must move to Open Championship the following calendar year.

When a third 1st place win is achieved over several calendar years, the dancer must move to Open Championship the following weekend.

Awards will be presented for soft and heavy shoe.
